We have also been working on sets of questions that will help us assess and identify how we can best encourage and equip a specific church and its members to reach and teach children. Adi has been meeting regularly with Ionut Mateescu, the Child Evangelism Fellowship local workers for our county, Timis. We are encouraged by his willingness to meet for fellowship, accountability, sharing of ideas and prayer. He is passionate about sharing the gospel with children and equipping others to do so. We are thankful that God has brought about this relationship and we are looking forward to seeing how God will continue to use this for his glory. We have also started the process of contacting pastors, leaders and ministry workers who we are already in relationship with to get their feedback and advice as to how we can continue and what the next steps may be. These processes may seem drawn out, but we have been encouraged to make prayerful, considered foundations first. We are being intentional about praying about all these various stages and we pray that you would join us as we continue to seek the Lord's guidance and wisdom as to how best to serve local Romanian Christians by encouraging and equipping them to reach children in their communities with the lifesaving gospel of Jesus.
